



## The Pulaski Fine Arts Association Albie Frizzle Memorial Scholarship Program

The goal of the Pulaski Fine Arts Association (PFAA) scholarship program is to provide financial assistance to a graduating High School senior of good character who has demonstrated excellence in the field of drama, music, or art and is pursuing a degree in one of the aforementioned studies. The scholarship is a one-time award of \$500.00 to the most qualified applicant as determined by the PFAA Scholarship Committee.

The Vice President of the PFAA will act as Chairman of the Scholarship Committee. The committee will select the most qualified applicant declaring a major in drama, music, or art. Applicants not declaring a major in one of these fields will not be considered for this scholarship.

The Scholarship Committee will consist of a minimum of three judges, if two or more qualified applications are received. The points will be consolidated by the Chairman who will deem the winner from the combined points. In the case of only one qualified application the Chairman is not required to form a committee to deem the winner. Scholarship Application Judging Forms will be provided to the committee with the applications.

All Pulaski County High Schools (Crocker, Dixon, Laquey, Richland, and Waynesville) will be provided with PFAA Scholarship Application Packets annually. Once a winner has been selected, the Scholarship Committee will notify the PFAA Board and the Senior Counselor at the High School of the recipient.

The Chairman of the Scholarship Committee will present the Scholarship at the winner's High School Awards Ceremony. If the Chairman is not available another PFAA Board member will present the award for the PFAA.
